



COVID-19 requirements for events at Iron Horse Park

We look forward to hosting your party at Iron Horse Park. For the safety of your family and all of our guests, you and all guests at your event must be prepared to comply with all current requirements from Alberta Health Services and the Province of Alberta related to COVID-19.

Iron Horse Park reserves the right to remove any booked event with no refund if full compliance of the below items and / or all AHS/Provincial requirements are not maintained during your booking BY ALL GUESTS.

A maximum of 30 people (within current COVID-19 cohort size restrictions for outdoor events) are allowed per event site, including adults and children.

- Please check, follow and respect all guidelines in place regarding cohort size for COVID-19 if they have changed at the time of your party. To learn more, visit <https://www.alberta.ca/assets/documents/covid-19-relaunch-guidance-cohorts.pdf>

All of our event areas are cleaned between each rental group. However, please bring your own bleach spray / sanitizer spray and paper towels as required to sanitize your rented area before use, for your own comfort level.

- Hand sanitizer is provided prior to riding the train. However, groups are responsible to bring their own sanitizer for use during the event / at your party site.

Non-medical masks are REQUIRED for all adults (14+) while in store vicinity, in line or on the train.

- Non-medical masks are not available for purchase from IHP on the day of your event. Please PLAN AHEAD.
- Masks do not have to be worn while at your event site. They are strongly recommended to be worn by adults while inside your event site structure, if applicable.

Only one adult per family is allowed in the store vicinity on arrival to check in the event.

Credit cards or debit only at this time.

When it is your group's turn to ride the train, please remind all adults riding that they require non-medical masks to ride. All members will be required to sanitize hands before riding.

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If any of your guests answer YES to any of the questions below they must NOT participate today.

1 - Do you have any new onset (or worsening) of any of the following symptoms from an unknown source, not explained by a pre-existing condition:

Fever --- Cough ---- Sore throat ---- Chills ---- Headache
Shortness of Breath / Difficulty Breathing ---- Painful swallowing
Runny Nose / Nasal Congestion
Feeling unwell / Fatigued
Nausea / Vomiting / Diarrhea
Unexplained loss of appetite
Loss of sense of taste or smell
Muscle/ Joint aches
Conjunctivitis (commonly known as pink eye)

2 - Have you travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days?

3 - Have you had close unprotected contact (face-to-face contact within 2 meters/6 feet)

with someone who has travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days and who is ill?
or someone who is still ill,
or someone who has been diagnosed with Covid-19

Here are SOME highlights relevant to Iron Horse Park Birthday Parties due to Covid-19.

- Infants and children should remain with their parents or guardians at all times.
- Provide hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content for your guests to use.
- Avoid activities that do not allow physical distancing, such as party games or crowding together for photographs.
- Discourage hugging, holding hands, hand shaking (e.g., receiving lines) and the sharing of communal items (e.g., pens, guest books).
- Attendees should bring their own food and beverages. Food and beverages should not be shared between different households.
- Cooking of food including BBQ is not allowed on site.
- Use single use/disposable plates, cutlery, cups, etc.
- Gifts should be placed in a designated area and preferably opened at home. Gifts that cannot be cleaned and disinfected should be left untouched for 24 hours. When handling gifts, follow hand hygiene practices.
- No more than 6 individuals should be seated at a table. Tables are arranged so that a 2-Metre distance is maintained between each dining party.
